What is the Earth Day Expo?

The Earth Day Expo is a whole day excursion filled with fun, interactive activities presented by environmental organisations that are passionate about a sustainable future for our planet. Around 20 different environmental educators from government, non-government and local volunteer groups provide hands-on activities aimed at empowering young people to think creatively and critically about how to generate sustainable change.

Why celebrate Earth Day?

Earth Day is celebrated by more than 300 countries around the world. This day reminds us we all share the same planet. Sharing the Earth means taking responsibility for what we use and how we use it. It is a day to think of the environmental challenges we face and how to solve them. Internationally, *Earth Day* is held on 22 April each year. We celebrate it on a different date to suit the school calendar and provide the opportunity for around 600 primary school students to participate in the day.

How does the Earth Day Expo link with the WA Curriculum?

The *Earth Day Expo* provides a great opportunity to address the learning areas of Science, Humanities, Technology and Maths as well as the cross-curricular priorities of Sustainability and A&TSI Histories and Cultures.
