Recycling at Home

Depending on where you live in Perth, the RULES for what you can put in your <u>GREEN</u> and <u>YELLOW</u> bins may be different.

Some items that have special requirements for disposal. These include:

Hazardous Household Waste

Dangerous chemicals –
Pesticides, Weed Killers,
Fertilisers, Paints, Turpentine,
Flammable liquids – petrol,
kerosene etc, Bleaches and other
cleaning liquids and Batteries

Construction and Demolition Materials
Building materials including Bricks,
Concrete, Timber, Metal beams, dirt and soil

Other Products

Mobile phones, Rubber tyres, Car parts,
Medicines and Large
Household items – old white goods, electrical appliances etc

Check with your <u>local council</u> if you're NOT SURE which bin to use for a waste item.



Check with your <u>local council</u> for the locations of TRANSFER STATIONS within your local area



BE AWARE:

The rules for how to dispose of your household waste may change over time. Always read new information sent to you by your local council.

Most local councils are members of Regional
Councils and these Regional Councils are
responsible for managing household waste
within the Perth Metropolitan Region.
Each Regional Council use different processes
to manage the contents of the green and yellow
bins – so this means that the rules for each local
council may be DIFFERENT.
